

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING ON MARCH 1 REGARDING THE PROPOSED
WIDENING OF U.S. 74 BETWEEN N.C. 200 (DICKERSON BOULEVARD) AND ROCKY
RIVER ROAD (S.R. 1007) INCLUDING IMPROVING U.S. 74 AND SECREST SHORTCUT
ROAD INTERSECTION
IN UNION COUNTY**

STIP Project No. U-5764 & U-5931

The N.C. Department of Transportation proposes widening the existing roadway of U.S. 74 between N.C. 200 (Dickerson Boulevard) to Rocky River Road (S.R. 1007). A related project will provide improvements at the intersection of U.S. 74 and Secrest Shortcut Road.

A public meeting will be held at **Shiloh Baptist Church** located at **2301 N Rocky River Road** on **Thursday, March 1st from 4 to 7 p.m.**

The public may attend at any time during the public meeting hours, as no formal presentation will be made. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments. The comments and information received will be taken into consideration as work on the project develops.
