

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING ON NOV. 27 REGARDING THE PROPOSAL TO WIDEN
U.S. 21 FROM PUMP STATION ROAD (S.R. 1933) TO FORT DOBBS ROAD AND REALIGN OFFSET
INTERSECTIONS OF SHUMAKER DRIVE (S.R. 1922) AND JANE SOWERS ROAD (S.R. 2171)
IN IREDELL COUNTY**

STIP Project No. U-5799

The N.C. Department of Transportation proposes to widen U.S. 21 to a multi-lane road from Pump Station Road (S.R. 1933) to north of Fort Dobbs Road, a distance of approximately 0.9 miles. In addition, the project would realign the offset intersections of Shumaker Drive (S.R. 1922) and Jane Sowers Road (S.R. 2171) at U.S. 21.

The purpose of the project is to add capacity to existing U.S. 21, improve pedestrian and bicycle mobility, and address roadway operational and design deficiencies related to the offset intersections at U.S. 21 and Jane Sowers Road (S.R. 2171)/Shumaker Drive (S.R. 1922).

A public meeting will be held from 4-7 p.m. on Tuesday, Nov. 27 at the **Fairview Baptist Church** located at **349 Turnersburg Hwy.**

The purpose of this meeting is to inform the public of the project and gather input on the proposed design. As information becomes available, it may be viewed online at the NCDOT Public Meeting Webpage: <https://www.ncdot.gov/news/public-meetings>.

The public may attend at any time during the public meeting hours, as no formal presentation will be made. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments. The comments and information received will be taken into consideration as work on the project develops.
