

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING FOR THE PROPOSED
IMPROVEMENTS AT THE U.S. 301 (WALL STREET) AND
N.C. 50 (MAIN STREET) INTERSECTION
IN JOHNSTON COUNTY**

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed improvements at the U.S. 301 (Wall Street) and N.C. 50 (Main Street) intersection in Johnston County. The proposed improvements will consist of the installation of a mini roundabout to reduce crashes and improve pedestrian safety.

The meeting will be held on **Tuesday, November 13, 2018** at the **Benson Town Hall** located at **303 East Church Street** in **Benson** from **5-7 p.m.** The public may attend at any time during the meeting hours. Please note there will be no formal presentation.

At the meeting there will be maps of the proposed plans as well as project team members who will be available to answer your questions and receive feedback. All comments will be taken into consideration as the project progresses. The opportunity to submit written comments will be provided at the meeting or can be done via phone, email, or mail no later than **November 27, 2018**.
