

NCDOT RE-SCHEDULED PUBLIC MEETING ON FEB. 13 REGARDING THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE INTERSECTION OF N.C. 410 AND N.C. 41 IN BLADEN COUNTY

The N.C. Department of Transportation (NCDOT) proposes to improve the existing intersection of N.C. 410 and N.C. 41 by converting the intersection to a roundabout.

A public meeting will be held at **Bladen Community College located at 7418 N.C. 41 on Tuesday, February 13th from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m.**
