NOW, THEREFORE, I, BEVERLY EAVES PERDUE, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim the month of April 2010, as **"WORK ZONE SAFETY AWARENESS MONTH,"** and the week of April 19-23, 2010, as **"WORK ZONE SAFETY AWARENESS WEEK"** throughout North Carolina. I encourage all citizens to recognize during this special time and throughout the year, the care, caution and patience that should be exercised in work zones.
