FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Will a student be disqualified if he or she is over 18 years of age?

A: No. As long as the student has not graduated from high school, he or she is qualified to participate in the contest.

Q: Will a student be disqualified if he or she uses a media on the non-permissible media list?

A: Yes.

Q: Where do I attach the completed entry form?

A: Attach the entry form to the back of the poster using staples or tape. *Please do not use paperclips.*

Q: Who will judge the entries?

A: The NCDOT Work Zone Safety Work Group.

Q: How will the winner receive his or her check?

A: The check will be written to the winner and either personally presented or sent to the school address provided on the entry form.

Q: Who will receive a copy of the calendar once it is finished?

A: The winner and his or her teacher and classmates will receive a copy of the calendar once it is printed. We will also send several extra copies to each winning school. The calendar will also be available by request.

Q: Will my entry be returned?

A: No.

Q: Can NCDOT use my entry for other initiatives?

A: Yes, all entries become the property of NCDOT and will not be returned. However, credit will be given if the art is used in other safety campaigns.
