




64 US 64 ASHEBORO BYPASS
RANDOLPH COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

Project Information

Length: 14.6 miles
Typical Section: Four-lane, median-divided road



Right of Way: Total width – about 400 feet for roadway, wider at interchanges
Access Control: US 64 Asheboro Bypass – full control of access (Access provided by interchange only; no driveway access)

Design-Build Process

The Design-Build process has several potential benefits in addition to faster project completion. The Design-Build team looks for innovative designs that meet the project specifications but reduces costs and impacts. By working together, the designer and contractor may also quickly resolve issues that arise during construction, potentially resulting in creative and flexible solutions

Modifications being presented tonight have been made to reduce the number of parcels being impacted as well as utility impacts, which will result in lower construction costs.

Eastern End Modifications

Originally the eastern section was proposed to be constructed mainly in the area just north of Trogon Hill Road. This design affected approximately 40 residences, businesses and churches, and would require significant utility relocations.

The proposed modifications to this design, shifting the alignment to the northwest will reduce the number of affected residences or businesses and significantly reduce the number of utility relocations.


U.S. 64 Asheboro Bypass (Eastern Section)

State Transportation Improvement Program Project R-2536

Project Description

The N.C. Department of Transportation is planning to improve U.S. 64 in the Asheboro area. The proposed project is a new 14.6-mile freeway bypassing Asheboro to the south. The project begins on U.S. 64 west of Asheboro just east of Stutts Road and ends at U.S. 64 east of Asheboro at Dewey Road. This project is being constructed as a Design-Build project. The Design-Build Process allows NCDOT to contract with a Team of designers and contractors that is responsible for the design, right of way acquisition, and construction of a project. The Team may begin construction while they finish the design and right of way acquisition resulting in faster project completion.
