The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) is constantly working to provide better and safer transportation facilities for public use in North Carolina. Every two years the NCDOT develops the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), a seven-year plan identifying the transportation needs of the state. The TIP outlines proposed improvements to existing facilities as well as new facilities to be constructed.

This is to notify you that the NCDOT has authorized the identification of proposed right of way and easements for the above project. Engineers and surveyors representing NCDOT will be working on or near your property staking proposed road centerlines, easements, and rights of way necessary for the construction and maintenance of this transportation facility. These survey stakes and points are generally placed before an NCDOT Right of Way negotiator contacts the owner(s) of any affected property. These easement and right of way points are proposed and do not become final until after a settlement is reached with the property owner. These points are staked in advance to serve as a visual reference during the right-of-way negotiations phase.
