


# Recommended Route Selected for Improvements to NC 109

The N. C. Department of Transportation has announced the selection of **Alternative 6** as the recommended route for improving NC 109 between Old Greensboro Road in Davidson County and I-40/US311 in Forsyth County. A map of Alternative 6 is shown at right.

On August 11, 2011, NCDOT personnel met with staff from state and federal agencies to review the numerous public comments received on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement published in the fall of 2010 and the two Public Hearings held in January 2011. The team also evaluated the potential impacts of the five routes under consideration. Based on this information, Alternative 6 was selected as having the best balance of impacts to the natural and human environments while removing the most traffic from existing NC 109.

NCDOT will now continue developing the Final Environmental Impact Statement for the project and will prepare final design plans. We anticipate completing this work next summer and will hold a design public hearing at that time to give you an opportunity to share your thoughts.


# Recommended Route Selected for Improvements to NC 109
