Construction includes new 9.4 mile, four-lane interstate highway with two interchanges, and bridges over Reedy Fork Creek, as well as a taxiway at Piedmont Triad International Airport.

In the planning stages since the mid 1990's, this project is Rockingham County's top priority transportation improvement project. It is among the top priority projects for Guilford County, as well.


The Connector will be signed I-73 when complete.

January 2015 Construction Update

As progress continues on the US 220/NC 68 Connector and PTI Taxiway Bridge, the Joint Venture plans to permanently close Regional Road at Pleasant Road in Greensboro so crews can begin construction on the next phase of the Future I-73.

As part of the I-73 project which connects US 220 to NC 68, Regional Road will be permanently closed where it connects to Pleasant Ridge Road. The closure will take place on February 2, 2015 at approximately 10:00 a.m. After this closure is in place, motorists wishing to travel on Regional Road will have to access using Joseph M. Bryan Boulevard.

Motorists are advised to use caution as construction activities increase and additional equipment and crews were working in the area.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- **I-5110 Project:**
All environmental permits were received this month as well as the final roadway, drainage, and erosion control designs. With the accomplishment of these major milestones, construction for this portion of the project is now sanctioned to start.
