

**NOTICE OF PRE-CONSTRUCTION PUBLIC OPEN HOUSES IN JULY FOR  
PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO I-485 BETWEEN  
I-77 AND U.S. 74 (INDEPENDENCE BOULEVARD)**

The North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) will hold two public open houses at the following times and locations:

The proposed project would add one express lane in each direction on I-485 between I-77 and U.S. 74 (Independence Boulevard), providing travel time reliability and improving traffic flows on this critical transportation corridor. This project would also add one general purpose lane in each direction between Rea Road and Providence Road. In coordination with other projects in south/southeastern Mecklenburg County, this project would serve as part of a larger network of express lanes offering drivers the option of more reliable travel times.

NCDOT representatives will be available in an informal, open house-style setting to answer questions and gather public input regarding the proposed project. The opportunity to submit written comments or questions will be provided and is encouraged. Citizens may attend either open house at any time between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m.. There will be no formal presentation.
