

Holiday lane closing restrictions:

- New Year's Day from 6 p.m., Dec. 31, until 7 a.m., Jan. 2.
- Easter from 6 p.m. on the Thursday before the holiday, until 7 a.m. on the Monday after.
- Memorial Day from 6 p.m., Friday, until 7 a.m., Tuesday.
- Independence Day from 6 p.m. on the day before the holiday, until 7 a.m. on the day after. If the holiday lands on a Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday, then there will be no lane closures from 6 p.m. the Thursday before until 7 a.m. the Tuesday after.
- Labor Day from the hours of 6 p.m., Friday until 7 a.m., Tuesday.
- Thanksgiving from 6 p.m., Tuesday until 7 a.m., Monday.
- Christmas from 6 p.m. the Friday before the week of Christmas Day, until 7 a.m. the following Tuesday after the week of Christmas Day.

Special event lane closing restrictions:

- During the state fair, from 9 p.m. to 12 a.m.
- Football games at Carter-Finley Stadium – a lane can not be closed on I-40 East and Wade Avenue westbound three hours before the game and I-40 West from the end of a game to two hours after the end of the game.
- Any major event at the RBC Center, Carter Finley Stadium and / or the fairgrounds – a lane can not be closed on I-40 East and Wade Avenue eastbound and westbound from one hour before an event to the start of the event and on I-40 West from the end of an event to one hour after the end of an event as directed by the Engineer.
