

**Future Scenario
Control Totals**

The following information was taken from the **Draft Moore County Land Use Plan** , dated February 25, 2013:
Based on current population growth rates of **1.8%** and the projections from

the North Carolina Office of State Budget and Management (OSBM):

1. Moore County is projected to grow by over **28,000** people by 2030.
2. Using the current rate of **2.35** persons/household, this would require a total of **12,000** new residential units by 2030.
3. To maintain the growth rate, **9,400** new non-residential jobs and **1,500** new industrial jobs would have been created.
