Subject: Update on the Moore County CTP

I am writing to provide an update to the status of the Moore County Comprehensive Transportation Plan. Since our last meeting in July 2013, we have met with various municipalities and the Midway community within the county.

On October 29th, NCDOT was invited to participate in the Midway Small Area Plan meeting hosted by the Town of Aberdeen. As a participant of the community meeting, NCDOT was able to revisit the Midway community and share how the transportation planning process works and why it is important for Moore County citizens to provide their input. We were also able to explore and work toward improving outreach methods.

Approval at the municipal and county levels of the local socio-economic data that has been collected and compiled by MCTC representatives is underway. NCDOT began presenting socio-economic information (household, employment, and population) to local municipalities in October 2013. We have received favorable feedback (including some revisions that the MCTC representatives and local boards have recommended). The Village of Pinehurst council has approved its data and we are expecting approvals from Aberdeen and Foxfire in upcoming weeks. To date the following municipality boards have been presented with the MCTC sponsored socioeconomic data:

Southern Pines – October 28, 2013

Aberdeen – December 3, 2013

Pinehurst – December 10, 2013

Foxfire – December 10, 2013

Robbins – January 9, 2014

Pinebluff – January 16, 2014

The next phase entails entering data into the travel demand model that is under development. We will look to schedule a meeting with the MCTC in the near future to discuss future year road deficiencies (roads with more traffic than they are designed to handle).

Finally, we would like to extend congratulations to the county as well as the Walthour-Moss Foundation for being recognized and registered as a historical landmark within Moore County.

Your assistance with the meetings has been greatly appreciated as we have traveled around the county in recent months. I look forward to continuing to work with you in the coming months.
