The North Carolina Department of Transportation has been working to alleviate traffic congestion at Eastwood Road (U.S. 74) and Military Cutoff Road (U.S. 76/U.S. 17) and improve carrying capacity and operation.

Traffic Data

Traffic counts are expected to increase significantly in the next 20 years. The proposed improvements will accommodate a higher traffic capacity while maintaining an acceptable speed of travel through the corridor.

Purpose of the Meeting

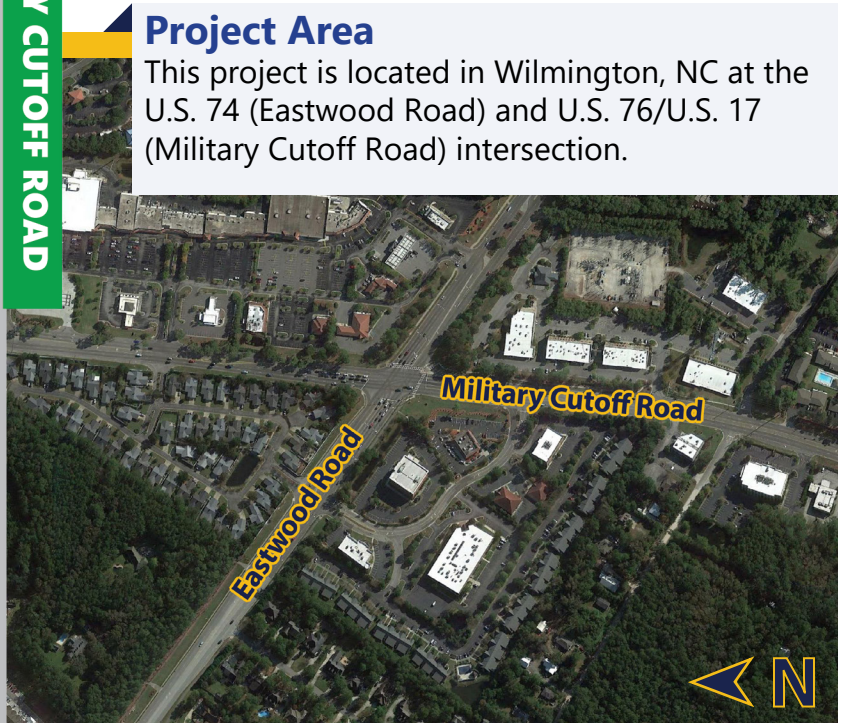
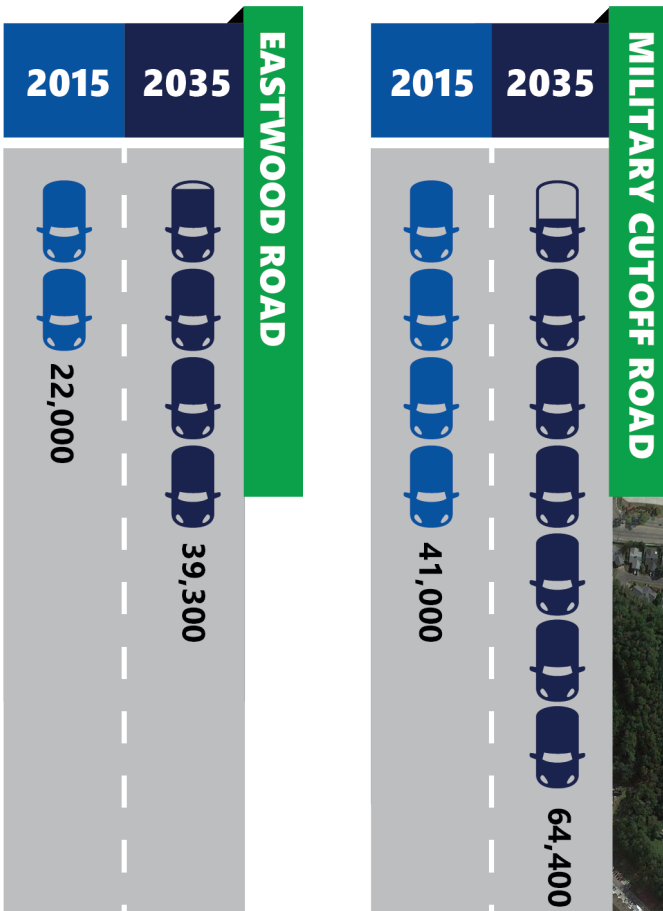
The purpose of the meeting is to allow the local community and project stakeholders an opportunity to:
