What to Expect at the Hearing:

This pre-hearing open house and Transportation Corridor Official Map Act is being held in compliance with Transportation Corridor Official Map Act (North Carolina General Statute 136-44.50). The purpose of the hearing is to explain the changes to the Protected Corridor in more detail.

Maps showing the road plans and the updated Protected Corridor will be on display. The open house will use a drop-in format to present this information and will provide an opportunity to review maps in more detail and ask questions. The presentation beginning at 7 p.m. will explain the right of way and relocation procedures and the corridor protection. After the presentation, there will be the opportunity for citizens to make public comments.

Anyone wishing to speak at the hearing may register to do so by contacting Drew Joyner prior to the hearing or by signing up at the pre-hearing open house, immediately prior to the 7:00 p.m. hearing. A five-minute time limit will be imposed for speaking in order to allow a fair opportunity for all those wishing to do so.

NCDOT to Hold Transportation Corridor Official Map Act Public Hearing and Pre-Hearing Open House for Changes to the Western Section on June 25, 2013

The NC Department of Transportation will hold a Transportation Corridor Official Map Act public hearing and a pre-hearing open house for the Winston-Salem Northern Beltway “Western Section.” See the yellow box below for the meeting time and location.

A “Protected Corridor” has been identified that includes the areas of the beltway that the Department expects to purchase to build the proposed road. As a result of funding and design changes during development of final designs, NCDOT is proposing to modify the Protected Corridor for the western section of the beltway.

Some properties that were previously in the corridor are no longer protected, while other properties that were not protected are now part of the Protected Corridor. Three changes to the Official Map are proposed, as described on the map in this newsletter (pages 2 and 3).

The open house from 4 - 6:30 p.m. will use a drop-in format to provide an opportunity to review the maps in more detail and ask questions. Interested citizens may attend at any time during the open house. A formal presentation will begin at 7 p.m. More information about the hearing format is on page 4 of this newsletter.

Project R-2247, Project U-2579, and Project U-2579A

Three changes to the Transportation Corridor Official Map are proposed: (1) The interchange of the beltway with Bethania-Tobaccoville Road has been re-designed to avoid impacts to a historic property. The revised corridor will be added to the Official Map, and the portion of the corridor that is no longer impacted will be removed from the Official Map. (2) At the previous Corridor Protection Public Hearing, the section of the beltway from U.S. 421 to Robinhood Road was not protected by the Transportation Corridor Official Map Act, because right-of-way acquisition was already under way in that area. Since that time, funding for the project was delayed and right-of-way acquisition was put on hold. Therefore, this section will now be added to the Official Map to limit further development in the corridor. Minimal changes have been made to the design in this section. (3) A previously proposed access road from Tilmark Drive to Peace Haven Road, near the I-40/US 421 interchange, has been removed. The corridor will be revised to no longer include the properties in that area.


