RALEIGH — The N.C. Turnpike Authority (NCTA) will hold an Optional Industry Forum for the Monroe Connector/Bypass on Wednesday, March 31 at 10:00 a.m. at the Helms Forum Student Center at Wingate University, 211 E. Wilson Street.
