State Contractor Management Engineer as follows: 6 7 (1) The appeal shall be received by the Department within 30 calendar days of the notice of denial. 8 Upon receipt of the appeal, the State Contractor Management Engineer DBE/UCP Program 9 Manager shall schedule a hearing for the firm with the Department's Disadvantaged Business 10 Enterprise, Minority Business Enterprise, Women Business Enterprise Appeals Committee. 11 (2) If the denial of certification or decertification is upheld by the Department's appeals committee, the 12 Minority Business Enterprise firm or Women Business Enterprise firm may file a written appeal to 13 the Secretary of Transportation within 30 days of the committee's decision. 14 (3) If the denial of certification is upheld by the Secretary of Transportation, the decision shall be final. 15 (b) Any Disadvantaged Business Enterprise firm denied certification or decertified may file an appeal of that action 16 as follows: 17 (1) The Disadvantaged Business Enterprise firm may file an appeal to the Department's DBE/UCP 18 Program Manager. State Contractor Management Engineer. The appeal shall be received by the 19 Department within 30 calendar days of the notice of denial.
