The public hearing is an opportunity for you, the public, to be involved in the rule making process, and is being held to solicit comments regarding the request to amend, adopt or repeal portions of the NC Administrative Code per the rules process.

This can be done by having them recorded at the Formal Public Hearing or by providing them in writing. Several representatives of the North Carolina Department of Transportation are present. They will be happy to talk with you and answer your questions. Everyone present is urged to participate in the proceedings. It is important, however, that **THE OPINIONS OF ALL INDIVIDUALS BE RESPECTED REGARDLESS OF HOW DIVERGENT THEY MAY BE FROM YOUR OWN.** Accordingly, debates are out of place at public hearings. Also, the public hearing is not to be used as a popular referendum to determine the location and/or design by a majority vote of those present.

WHAT IS DONE WITH THE INPUT?

All input received through the public hearing process will be reviewed by the Administrative and Engineering staffs of NCDOT prior to adoption of the proposed temporary rules. The Department will then submit the adopted proposed temporary rules to the Rules Review Commission with the Office of Administrative Hearings for review.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

- Pursuant to G.S. 150B-21.3A, Periodic Review and Expiration of Existing Rules, all rules are reviewed at least every 10 years or they shall expire. As a result of the periodic review of Subchapter 19A NCAC 06C, this rule was determined as "Necessary With Substantive Public Interest" thus necessitating readoption. Upon review for the readoption process, the agency deemed the rule to be unnecessary and is recommending repeal.
- The rule "Designing for Bicycles and Bikeways" has been in effect since 1979; all rules are reviewed at least every 10 years.
- While conducting its latest review, the N.C. Department of Transportation determined the rule is unnecessary as the department is required to follow the design criteria in federal and state requirements for designing for bicycles and by its <u>Complete Streets</u> policy.

6	(1)	- New bridges, grade separated interchanges, tunnels, and viaducts are to be designed to give safe access to	
7		bicycles.	
8	(2)	All improvements to bridges, grade separated interchanges, tunnels, and viaducts are to be designed to give	
9		safe access to bicycles where feasible.	
10	(3)	Secondary bicycle facilities shall be designed to be within highway rights of way.	
11	(4)	Paved shoulders shall be designed in a manner which will accommodate bicycle traffic.
