The Division may issue a permanent registration plate for a motor vehicle owned by one of the entities authorized to have a permanent registration plate. To obtain a permanent registration plate, an authorized representative of the entity must provide proof of ownership, provide proof of financial responsibility as required by General Statute 20-309, and pay a fee of six dollars (\$6.00). A permanent plate may be transferred as provided in General Statute 20-78 to a replacement vehicle of the same classification for a fee of \$21.50 and if lost may be replaced for a fee of \$21.50.
