If the vehicle used for testing is not equipped with air brakes, license must show an "L" - no air brake equipped CMV restriction.		
If the vehicle used for testing is equipped with air over hydraulic brakes, license must show a "Z" - no full air brake equipped CMV restriction.		
Vehicle used for testing is equipped with an automatic transmission, license must show an " <i>E</i> " – <i>no manual transmission equipped CMV</i> restriction.		
Vehicle combination used for testing is not a truck-tractor semi-trailer combination, license must show an		

"O" – no tractor trailer CMV restriction.

"K" - Intrastate only. (Under the age of 21, medical waiver)

"M" – Passenger Class B & C (Applies when the driver has a class A CDL but takes skills test for the passenger endorsement in a class B vehicle

"N" Passenger Class B & C (Applies when the driver has a class A or B CDL but takes skills test for the passenger endorsement in a class C vehicle
