The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed project to replace Bridge No. 325 on Rones Chapel Road (S.R. 1004) over a branch of the Northeast Cape Fear River in Duplin County. The purpose of this project is to provide safer and more efficient traffic operations. The existing bridge is considered structurally deficient according to Federal Highway Administration Standards and is reaching the end of its useful life.

The opportunity to submit written comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email, or mail by April 14, 2017. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops. Please note that no formal presentation will be made.
