

U.S. 21 (STATESVILLE ROAD) & CATAWBA AVENUE

INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS



WELCOME

The purpose of this Public Meeting is to present the preferred design concept for the U.S. 21 (Statesville Road) and Catawba Avenue intersection improvements project. This is an informal meeting where you are encouraged to view the project mapping and displays. Project team members are available to provide project information, answer questions, and receive your comments. Please use the comment form included in this handout to provide your feedback on the proposed improvements.

PROJECT NEED

The project area has experienced notable growth and development, leading to increased traffic volumes and congestion. Existing (2016) traffic volumes along Catawba Avenue and U.S. 21 (Statesville Road) in the project area are approximately 30,000 and 15,000 vehicles per day, respectively. Future (2040) traffic volumes along Catawba Avenue are projected to exceed 45,000 vehicles per day.

PROJECT OVERVIEW


The N.C. Department of Transportation evaluated several design options to improve traffic operations at the intersection of U.S. 21 (Statesville Road) and Catawba Avenue in Cornelius. These options included a roundabout, a quadrant intersection, a continuous flow intersection (CFI), and dual roundabouts. Additional information about these options is provided below. Based on a review of impacts associated with each option, and in coordination with the Town of Cornelius and neighborhoods adjacent to the project, the dual roundabout option was selected as the preferred alternative.



DESIGN CONCEPTS CONSIDERED

SINGLE ROUNDABOUT

The original plan for the intersection was to develop a single roundabout. However, based on additional traffic analysis and future traffic volumes, it was determined that a single roundabout would not provide a long-term solution for the intersection.



SOUTHEAST QUADRANT INTERSECTION

Although a quadrant intersection would provide improved traffic operations, it would have the most impacts to residents along S. Hill Street and Burton Lane, place additional traffic along Burton Lane, and limit access to businesses along U.S. 21 (Statesville Road). Therefore, this concept was eliminated from further consideration.



CONTINUOUS FLOW INTERSECTION (CFI)

A CFI would place additional traffic along Burton Lane, limit access to businesses along U.S. 21 (Statesville Road), and would not provide maximum traffic operations benefits compared to other concepts. For these reasons, the CFI was eliminated from further consideration.



PREFERRED DESIGN CONCEPT – DUAL ROUNDABOUTS

Dual roundabouts were selected as the preferred design concept because they have no additional traffic impacts to neighborhood streets, improve residential connectivity, provide safer pedestrian crossings, and notably improve traffic operations.
