Cultural Resources

 Historic Conclusion: No historic properties present or affected by this project.

NCDOT-Historic Architecture contracted with Louis Berger U.S., Inc. to carry out the necessary National Register (NR) eligibility evaluations. The resultant technical report (December 2017) assesses the Wildwood Presbyterian Church (CR1429), Albert Clyde Murdoch House (CR1430), Maggie E. Murdoch Watson House (CR 1431), and that part of the Norfolk Southern Railway Line within the APE (CR1432). The study concluded that the individual properties are not NReligible as they have suffered loss of historical integrity through structural change and attrition and also are surpassed in significance by more intact examples of comparable nineteenth-and early-twentieth-century resources located elsewhere in the county. The study also considered the possibility of a Wildwood Historic District, including not only the four evaluated resources but others in the vicinity, but found that the former cohesiveness and integrity of the railroad community are greatly diminished through loss and alteration of many component resources. The remaining elements of the community do not constitute a historic district that meets National Register criteria. HPO has reviewed the study and agreed with the conclusions (see attached correspondence).

No additional resources of concern are located in the APE, so a finding of "no historic properties present or affected" will satisfy both Section 106 and GS 121-12(a) compliance requirements.



- Improvement recommendations




Preliminary Alternatives Analysis




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




Old Murdoch Rd.




Old Murdoch Rd. (with walls)
