

**NCDOT TO HOLD PROJECT UPDATE MEETING FOR PROPOSED  
IMPROVEMENTS TO I-85 FROM U.S. 158 (MILEPOST 213.5) IN VANCE COUNTY  
TO VIRGINIA STATE LINE IN  
VANCE & WARREN COUNTIES**

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold two informal public meetings regarding the improvements to I-85 from U.S. 158 (milepost 213.5) in Vance County to the Virginia state line, currently under construction.

The purpose of this project is to address the deteriorating pavement conditions and improve operations and safety through rehabilitation and/or replacement. The project will also improve vertical clearance of the bridges.

The meetings will be held from 5 p.m. until 7 p.m. in an open house format.

The purpose of the meetings is to present the updated construction plans and explain how the contractor will construct the improvements. Display maps will be available to review at the meeting showing traffic control, phased lane closures, and ramp detours. The opportunity to submit written comments will also be provided at the meeting or should be sent in by **April 28, 2017**. Note: There will not be a formal presentation.
