

**NCDOT TO HOST A PUBLIC MEETING IN MAY FOR
THE PROPOSED CONVERSION OF THE I-440/U.S. 1 INTERCHANGE
AT WAKE FOREST ROAD TO A DIVERGING DIAMOND**

The N.C. Department of Transportation is proposing to convert the interchange on I-440/U.S. 1 at Wake Forest Road to a Diverging Diamond Interchange. The public meeting will be held at the **North Raleigh Hilton** located at **3415 Wake Forest Road**, in **Raleigh**, on **Thursday, May 17th** from **4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.**

The purpose of this meeting is to provide interested citizens with information on the project and gather public input on the proposed design.

Interested citizens may attend at any time between 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Please note that there will not be a formal presentation. NCDOT representatives will display maps and be available to answer questions and receive comments. Comments and information received will be taken into consideration as work on the project develops. Written comments or questions can also be submitted at the meeting or later by June 1, 2018.
