

## **Project Description**

The N.C. Department of Transportation proposes to improve the interchange at I-485 and Brookshire Boulevard (N.C. 16) in Mecklenburg County as part of the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Project No. I-5973. The project proposes additional northbound lanes on Brookshire Boulevard (N.C. 16) and will improve the Outer Loop ramps and intersections of N.C. 16 with the Inner and Outer Loop ramps (see map on page 2). All work is anticipated to be completed within the existing right-of-way.

# **Project Purpose**

The primary purpose of the project is to decrease delays on Brookshire Boulevard through the interchange based on projected 2040 traffic volumes. Without improvements, the I-485/Brookshire Boulevard (N.C. 16) Outer Loop intersection is expected to operate at an unacceptable level of service, with especially long delays southbound on Brookshire Boulevard and northbound on the I-485 off-ramp.


# Tonight's Meeting
