

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING  
FOR THE PROPOSED MAYNARD ROAD GRADE SEPARATION  
WAKE COUNTY**

**TIP PROJECT NO. P-5718**

The N.C. Department of Transportation has rescheduled the public meeting for the proposed project to construct a grade separation of the N.E. Maynard Road rail crossing of the Norfolk Southern/N.C. Railroad Line and CSX Line to replace the at-grade crossing in Cary. The informal public meeting originally scheduled for Thursday, September 20, has been rescheduled for **Tuesday, October 16, 2018** from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. at Herbert C. Young Community Center, Meeting Room B located at 101 Wilkinson Avenue in Cary.

The purpose of this project is to eliminate rail-highway conflicts at the existing at-grade railroad crossing location on N.E. Maynard Road near its intersection with E. Chatham Street. The proposed project will improve vehicular mobility and safety at this location and the surrounding area.

The public may drop-in at any time during the meeting hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project. The opportunity to submit comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email, or mail by October 31, 2018. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops. Please note that no formal presentation will be made.
