

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING
FOR THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS OF N.C. 24-27 FROM
N.C. 740 (SPAULDING STREET) IN ALBEMARLE TO EAST OF THE PEE DEE RIVER
STANLY AND MONTGOMERY COUNTIES**

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed project to widen N.C. 24-27 from N.C. 740 (Spaulding Street) in Albemarle to east of the Pee Dee River. Since the last public meeting (about 5 years ago), updates to the design have been recommended for the section of N.C. 24-27 (East Main Street) within the City of Albemarle limits. Changes includes a superstreet in this section and a roundabout at the intersection of Barnard Road and Anderson Road. The meeting will take place on Thursday, October 19, 2017 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Anderson Grove Baptist Church located at 2225 East Main Street in Albemarle.

The purpose of the public meeting will be to present the updated design for the section from Spaulding Street to Sweet Home Church Road, and gather input from the public on the changes.

The public may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project. The opportunity to submit written comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email, or mail by November 2, 2017. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops. Please note that no formal presentation will be made.
