

STIP Project R-2588B Proposed Widening of N.C. 191 from SR 1381 (Mountain Road) to N.C. 280 in Mills River, NC

March 15, 2018 Public Meeting 4-7 p.m.

The N.C. Department of Transportation is proposing to upgrade and widen existing N.C. 191 from SR 1381 (Mountain Road) to N.C. 280 for approximately 4.5 miles.

The purpose of this project is to improve safety and mobility along N.C. 191.

The project corridor experiences congestion during peak traffic hours which is projected to worsen in the future (12,400 vehicles per day currently use the corridor on average). The corridor also has a very high crash rate (257 crashes per million vehicle miles), well above the statewide average (197 crashes per million vehicle miles). The majority of these accidents are rear end crashes.

This meeting is an open forum for you to comment on the proposed design for this project. It is an opportunity for the project team to obtain public input on the project and to answer your questions one-on-one.

Improvements Being Considered

- Widen existing N.C. 191 to a four lane roadway with four 11-foot travel lanes, a 17.5 -foot median, 5-foot bike lanes, and curb and gutter.
- Construct a 10-foot multiuse path on N.C. 191 between Rugby Middle School and West Henderson High School.
- Improve drainage ditches and structures.




