The project is referred to as the N.C. 43 Connector and is proposed as a four-lane, median-divided, partial control of access facility on new location.

The purpose of the meeting is to allow the local community and project stakeholders an opportunity to:


- Provide information on the proposed improvements.

# **Purpose**

The purpose and need for this project is based on the economic development of Craven County, projected traffic volumes and continued needs for connectivity in the area. This project has multiple goals including:


