

**NCDOT TO HOLD A PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING THE PROPOSED

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed widening of N.C. 211 between N.C. 906 (Midway Road/Middleton Boulevard) to N.C. 87, in Brunswick County. The purpose of this project is to improve the traffic carrying capacity of N.C. 211 between N.C. 906 (Midway Road/Middleton Boulevard) and N.C. 87.

The meeting will take place on Thursday, October 5 at the Town of St. James Community Center, located at 4136 Southport-Supply Road SE from 4 to 7 p.m.

The public may attend at any time during the hours mentioned above. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project.
