WILLIAMSON ROAD (S.R. 1109) FROM I-77 TO BRAWLEY SCHOOL ROAD (S.R. 1100)  
IN IREDELL COUNTY**

The N.C. Department of Transportation proposes to widen Williamson Road (S.R. 1109) from I-77 to Brawley School Road (S.R. 1100) in Mooresville.

A public meeting will be held from 4-7 p.m. on Thursday, Nov. 29 at the **Harbor Church PCA** located at **433 Williamson Road**.
