

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING
FOR THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE N.C. 16 BUSINESS AND
TRIANGLE CIRCLE/UNITY CHURCH ROAD INTERSECTION
LINCOLN COUNTY**

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding proposed improvements to the signalized intersection of N.C. 16 Business and Triangle Circle (S.R. 1387)/Unity Church Road (S.R. 1439) in Lincoln County, by realigning the approaches to the intersection and adding turn lanes.

The meeting will be held on **April 19, 2018** at the **East Lincoln Community Center** located at **8160 Optimist Club Road in Denver** from **5 p.m. to 7 p.m.** The public may attend at any time during the meeting hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments regarding the project. The opportunity to submit comments will also be provided at the meeting or via telephone, email, or mail by **May 4, 2018**. All comments received will be taken into consideration as the project progresses. Please note that no formal presentation will be made.
