The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed project to upgrade and widen N.C. 46 from N.C. 48 in Gaston to the Virginia State Line. The meeting will take place on Tuesday, February 20, 2018 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Lake Gaston Community Center located at 564 N.C. 46 in Gaston.

The purpose of this project is to improve the safety and mobility along N.C. 46. The purpose of the public meeting will be to gather input from the public on preliminary designs.

The public may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project. The opportunity to submit comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email, or mail by March 20, 2018. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops.
