

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING ON APRIL 24 REGARDING THE PROPOSAL TO
IMPROVE THE RAILROAD CROSSING AT U.S. 311 AND N.C. 65 AND
CONSTRUCT
A ROUNDABOUT ON U.S. 311 (N. MAIN STREET) AT FIRST STREET (S.R. 1918)
IN STOKES COUNTY**

The N.C. Department of Transportation proposes improvements to railroad crossing at U.S. 311 and N.C. 65 and construction of a roundabout on U.S. 311 (N. Main Street) at First Street (S.R. 1918) in Walnut Cove.

A public meeting will be held at **Walnut Cove Public Library** located at **106 West Fifth Street** on **Tuesday, April 24th from 4 to 6 p.m.**
