

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING MARCH 22  
FOR PROPOSED U.S. 70 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS  
BETWEEN N.C. 903 AND JUST SOUTHEAST OF JIM SUTTON ROAD/WILLIE MEASLEY ROAD  
LA GRANGE, LENOIR COUNTY**

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting in March regarding proposed improvements to U.S. 70 between N.C. 903 and just southeast of the intersection with Jim Sutton Road (S.R. 1227)/Willie Measley Road (S. R. 1252). Proposed improvements include the conversion of the existing intersection of Jim Sutton Road/Willie Measley Road to an interchange.

The public meeting will be held **Thursday, March 22, 2018** between **5 and 7 p.m.** at the **La Grange Community Center** located at **410 East Washington Street** in **La Grange**.

At the meeting, maps of the proposed alternatives will be presented. Project team members will be available to discuss the project, answer questions, and provide feedback. Written comments or questions may be submitted at the meeting or via mail/email by April 12, 2018. Please note no formal presentation will be made.
