

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING NOV 29
FOR PROPOSED U.S. 70 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS
BETWEEN N.C. 903 AND JUST SOUTHEAST OF JIM SUTTON ROAD/WILLIE MEASLEY ROAD
LA GRANGE, LENOIR COUNTY**

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting in November regarding proposed improvements to U.S. 70 between N.C. 903 and just southeast of the intersection with Jim Sutton Road (S.R. 1227)/Willie Measley Road (S. R. 1252). Proposed improvements include the conversion of the existing intersection of Jim Sutton Road/Willie Measley Road to an interchange.

The public meeting will be held **Thursday, November 29, 2018** between **5 and 7 p.m.** at the **La Grange Community Center** located at **410 East Washington Street** in **La Grange**.

At the meeting, maps of the preferred alternative will be presented. Project team members will be available to discuss the project, answer questions, and provide feedback. Written comments or questions may be submitted at the meeting or via mail/email by December 12, 2018. Please note no formal presentation will be made.
