

**NCDOT TO HOLD A PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING THE PROPOSED

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed widening of U.S. 258 from N.C. 148 (C.F. Harvey Parkway) to approximately 0.5 mile south of Browntown Road (S.R. 1101).
