

**NCDOT RESCHEDULED PUBLIC MEETING
FOR THE PROPOSED INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS ON OLD LAKE ROAD (S.R. 1740)
AND CHAUNCEY TOWN ROAD (S.R. 1735) AT U.S. 74/76 AND N.C. 214
COLUMBUS COUNTY**

The public meeting, **originally scheduled for September 25**, regarding the proposed conversion of the intersection of U.S. 74/76 and Old Lake Road to a grade separation, the intersection of U.S. 74/76 and Chauncey Town Road to an interchange, and construction of roundabouts at the intersections of N.C. 214/Old Lake Road and N.C. 214/Chauncey Town Road in Lake Waccamaw has been rescheduled due to inclement weather. The public meeting **will now take place on Thursday, October 25** from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Boys and Girls Home, Fellowship Hall, located at 400 Flemington Drive in Lake Waccamaw.

The purpose of this project is to support the upgrade of U.S. 74 to a full-access-control facility. The conversion of the U.S. 74/Old Lake Road intersection to a grade separation will also improve safety for nearby high school traffic by restricting direct access by passenger vehicles and large trucks to and from U.S. 74. The construction of roundabouts at the N.C. 214 intersections with Chauncey Town Road and Old Lake Road will help facilitate the flow of additional traffic that will be diverted through Lake Waccamaw due to the proposed changes in U.S. 74 access.

The public may drop-in at any time during the meeting hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project. The opportunity to submit comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email, or mail by November 26, 2018. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops. Please note that no formal presentation will be made.
