The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed project to construct a superstreet intersection along U.S. 221 Business (South Jefferson Avenue) from N.C. 194 to Beaver Creek School Road (S.R. 1248) in West Jefferson. The meeting will take place on Thursday, July 26 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the West Jefferson Town Hall located at 1 South Jefferson Avenue in West Jefferson.

The public may drop-in at any time during the meeting hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project. The opportunity to submit comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email, or mail until August 10, 2018. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops. No formal presentation will be made.
