

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING PROPOSED
IMPROVEMENTS TO U.S. 64 BUSINESS BETWEEN U.S. 64 AND MAIN STREET (S.R. 1307)
HAYESVILLE, CLAY COUNTY**

STIP Project No. R-5863

The N.C. Department of Transportation is proposing to make improvements to approximately 1.2 miles of U.S. 64 Business between U.S. 64 and Main Street in Hayesville. The project is intended to improve traffic operations and safety.

An open-house public meeting will be held at the **First United Methodist Church** located at **989 U.S. 64 Business** in **Hayesville** from **4-7:00 p.m.** on Tuesday, **Aug. 14, 2018**. The purpose of this meeting is to provide interested citizens the opportunity to review maps of the project, ask questions and provide feedback.

Interested citizens may attend at any time. Please note that there will not be a formal presentation. Maps of the proposed improvements will be displayed at the meeting and staff of NCDOT will be on hand to provide information and answer questions.
