

NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARING IN MARCH ON PROPOSED RULE CHANGES TO THE NORTH CAROLINA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public hearing for three proposed rule changes on March 23 at 2 p.m. at the Greenfield Parkway Building – NCDOT Transportation Mobility and Safety Unit - Conference Room 161, 750 N. Greenfield Parkway, Garner.

This hearing is being held to solicit comments on the proposed change to Title 19A, of the North Carolina Administrative Code, Chapter 02, Subchapter D, Part 0818 (19A NCAC 02D.0818) and Chapter 03, Subchapter D, Parts 0219 (19A NCAC 03D .0219) and 0237 (19A NCAC 03D .0237). The proposed rule changes would revise the requirements for submittal of documentation for award of contracts (19A NCAC 02D.0818) and allow motor vehicle dealers to maintain required business records in an electronic format (19A NCAC 03D .0219; 19A NCAC 03D .0237) in order to be consistent with legislative changes.
