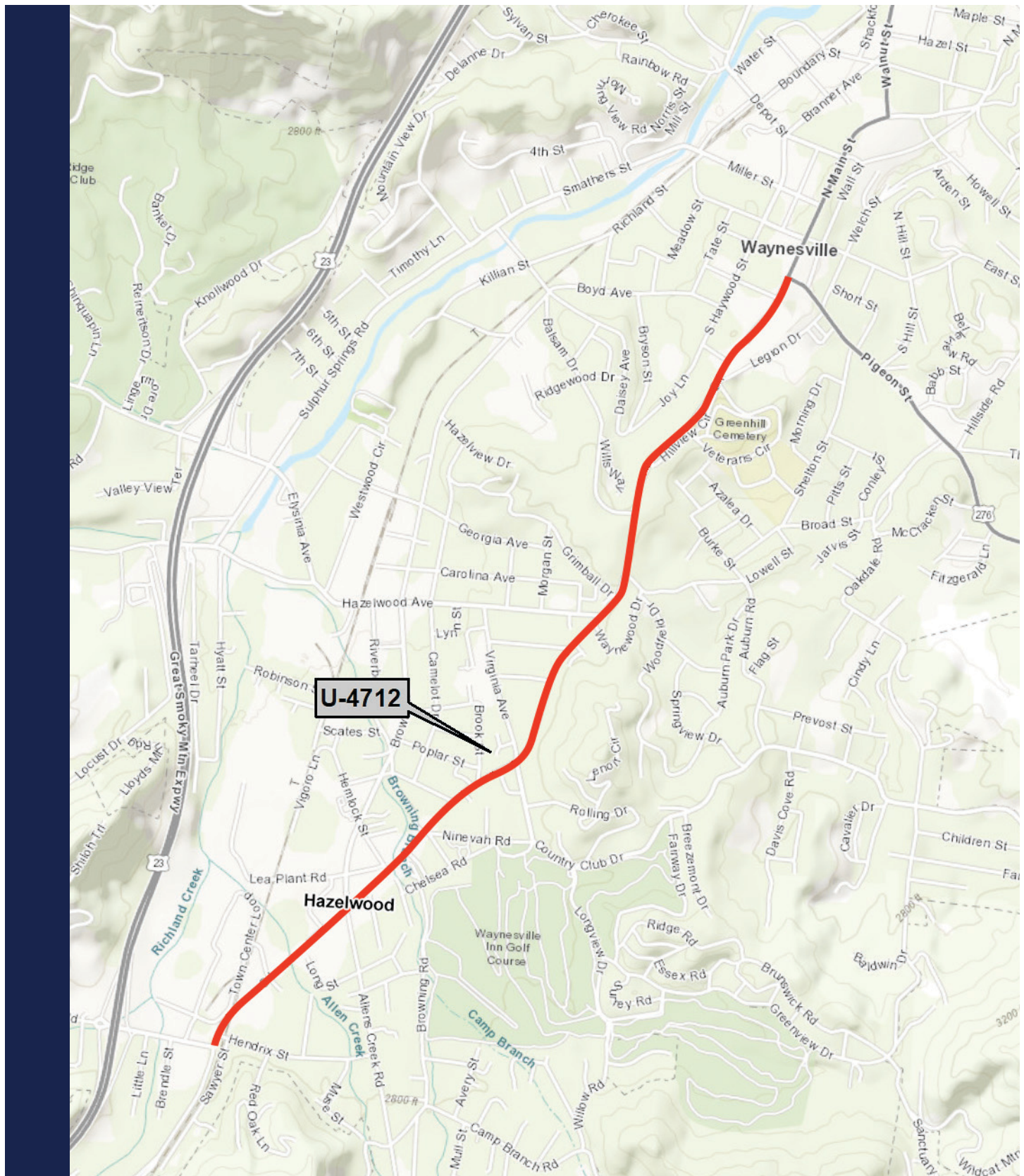
Project Schedule*
