

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING  
FOR THE PROPOSED EXTENSION OF NORTHCROSS DRIVE  
FROM N.C. 73 (SAM FURR ROAD) TO WESTMORELAND ROAD  
MECKLENBURG COUNTY**

**TIP PROJECT NO. U-5108**

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed project to extend Northcross Drive from its end near N.C. 73 (Sam Furr Road) in Huntersville to Westmoreland Road in Cornelius. The meeting will take place on Thursday, December 7, 2017 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Christ Community Church located at 16301 Old Statesville Road in Huntersville.

The purpose of the project is to improve the roadway network connectivity and provide an alternate north-south route for local traffic. Since the February 2017 public meeting, a preferred alignment has been chosen.

The public may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project. A map showing the detailed design of the selected alignment will be available for review. The opportunity to submit written comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email, or mail by January 5, 2018. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops. Please note that no formal presentation will be made.
