

NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING SEPTEMBER 28
FOR THE PROPOSED INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AT THE INTERSECTION OF
U.S. 501 (N. ROXBORO ROAD) WITH LATTA ROAD (S.R. 1448) AND INFINITY ROAD (S.R. 1639)
DURHAM COUNTY

The N. C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting in September regarding the proposed project to widen N. Roxboro Road and add dedicated right turn lanes in both directions of Latta Road (S.R. 1448) and Infinity Road (S.R. 1639). Sidewalks will be added on the north and south sides of both Latta and Infinity Road from the intersection at N. Roxboro.

The meeting will take place on **Thursday, September 28** at **Mount Sylvan United Methodist Church** located at **5731 N. Roxboro Road**, in **Durham** from **5 p.m. to 7 p.m.** Interested citizens may attend at any time during the meeting hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project. Please note that no formal presentation will be made. Citizens will also have the opportunity to submit comments and questions in writing. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops.
