The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed project to improve N.C. 105 from U.S. 321 (Blowing Rock Road) to the N.C. 105 Bypass in Boone. The meeting will take place on Tuesday, October 9 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Caldwell Community College and Technical Institute Watauga Campus, Building W372 located at 372 Community College Drive in Boone.

The purpose of this project is to alleviate existing congestion, improve travel conditions, and improve access management along N.C. 105 from U.S. 321 (Blowing Rock Road) to the N.C. 105 Bypass.

The public may drop-in at any time during the meeting hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project. The opportunity to submit comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email, or mail by October 24, 2018. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops.
