

**NCDOT TO HOLD A PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING THE PROPOSED  
WIDENING OF PINEVIEW STREET (S.R. 1712)  
FROM WEST OF SYLVAN DRIVE TO U.S. 220 BUSINESS  
IN RANDOLPH COUNTY**

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed widening of Pineview Street (S.R. 1712) from west of Sylvan Drive to U.S. 220 Business (N. Fayetteville Street), in Asheboro. The purpose of the proposed project is to improve traffic flow and safety along Pineview Street in Asheboro. The proposed improvements include widening Pineview Street from existing two lanes to three lanes with a center two-way left-turn lane.

The public meeting will take place on Tuesday, January 16, 2018 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Randleman Community Center, located at 144 W Academy Street in Randleman.

The public may attend at any time during the Public Meeting hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project. The opportunity to submit written comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email, or mail by February 15, 2018. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops. Please note that no formal presentation will be made.
