

**NCDOT TO HOLD PUBLIC MEETING
FOR THE PROPOSED WIDENING OF N.C. 125 FROM I-95 TO OLD FARM ROAD (S.R. 1752)
AND
CONSTRUCTION OF A ROAD ON NEW LOCATION
FROM N.C. 125 TO SOUTH OF U.S. 158
ROANOKE RAPIDS, HALIFAX COUNTY**

The N.C. Department of Transportation will hold a public meeting regarding the proposed projects to widen N.C. 125 from I-95 to Old Farm Road (S.R. 1752), and to construct a road on new location, Premier Boulevard (S.R. 1751) extension, from N.C. 125 to south of U.S. 158 in Roanoke Rapids. The meeting will take place on Tuesday, October 24, 2017 from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Lloyd Andrew City Meeting Hall located at 700 Jackson Street in Roanoke Rapids.

The purpose of widening N.C. 125 is to reduce congestion and improve highway access for residents and businesses. The purpose of extending Premier Boulevard is to promote economic development and improve mobility. The purpose of the public meeting will be to gather input from the public on the proposed designs.

The public may attend at any time during the above mentioned hours. NCDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and listen to comments regarding the project. The opportunity to submit written comments will also be provided at the meeting or via phone, email, or mail by November 7, 2017. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project develops. Please note that no formal presentation will be made.
