# **Project Description**

The N.C. Department of Transportation is preparing to widen N.C. 16 (Providence Road South) from Waxhaw Parkway (S.R. 3530) to Rea Road (S.R. 1316) in Union County.

# **Purpose of the Meeting**

The purpose of the meeting is to present the local community and project stakeholders with project updates incorporating feedback received at the initial public meeting held on November 5, 2018.

Project updates since November include the addition of U-turn bulbs and turning movements to improve mobility for side street users throughout the corridor.

Participants are encouraged to review updated maps and to discuss any questions or comments with members of the project team.

You are also encouraged to provide written comments by **March 28, 2019.** 

# Purpose of and Need for the Project

The purpose and need for this project is based on projected traffic volumes and continued needs for connectivity in the area. This project has multiple goals including:


- Improving and widening N.C. 16 from Rea Road to Waxhaw Parkway
- Alleviating existing and future congestion
- Improving safety through reduced conflict points
- Improving signal operation allowing more green time for the major streets
- Reducing congestion-related accidents




#### **TYPICAL SECTIONS**

The three proposed typical sections located in Union County, NC between Waxhaw Parkway and Rea Road.


#### FROM WAXHAW PARKWAY TO BRIDGE OVER TWELVE MILE CREEK

# What is a Michigan Left?

A Michigan Left is an innovative intersection design where left turns are not allowed at the main intersection. To make a left turn, instead of turning left at the intersection, you must go straight or turn right, and then make a U-turn at the median crossover.

### What are the advantages of a Michigan Left intersection?

#### REDUCED CONGESTION


Michigan Left intersections provide 20-50% greater capacity compared to traditional intersections as vehicles spend less time waiting at the signal for cars to turn left.

IMPROVED ROADWAY OPERATIONS

With fewer crashes and less congestion, a Michigan Left intersection will function better for all users.

### Why is a Michigan Left preferred for this project?

- It relocates the left turns away from the Providence/Rea Road intersection, which will improve roadway operations and safety for all users.
- It provides notable travel time improvement, especially in the morning peak hour.
- It impacts the least number of parcels when compared to other improvement alternatives.
